Instructions for Installing Sherron's Blender Mixer Brush

Installing Brushes:

- 1. Create a new folder and name it "Photoshop Brushes".
- 2. Save the .abr file into that folder.
- 3. To load the Mixer Brush, open Photoshop and go to Windows and open the Brushes Panel.
- 4. In the Brush Panel, open the pull-down list, located at the top right corner, and select "Import Brushes".
- 5. Navigate to the .abr file and click on "Load".
- 6. The brush will be installed into a "ss-Blender Mixer" folder and it will be the last folder in the Brush Panel.

How to Use the Mixer Brush:

- 1. Select the Mixed Brush (paint brush icon with paint drip) in the Toolbar. If you don't see the Mixer Brush, refer to the pdf on setting up your Toolbar.
- 2. In the Brush Panel, open the "ss-Blender Mixer" folder and highlight the "ss-Blender Mixer" brush.
- 3. Create a new empty layer
- 4. Make sure "Sample All Layers" is checked on the options bar at the top of the window. You don't need to change any of the other settings. The brush works well as is.
- 5. Enlarge or reduce the size of the brush as needed. The larger the brush the more it mixes.
- 6. Use a Layer Mask and the Layer Opacity to refine and reduce the effect.
